



22. Check throttle body. Clean if required.
23. Check battery level and lubricate terminals.
24. Check and top up all under bonnet fluid levels.
25. Replace air filter.\*
26. Replace spark plugs.\*
27. Replace fuel filter.\*
28. Replace pollen filter.\*


